1 YCRA Code of Conduct

- No physical violence and respect physical boundaries

- No bullying
- No homophobic, racist, sexist or discriminatory language
- Do not break the law
- Do create and be part of a welcoming and inclusive environment
- Respect your surroundings, including public spaces
- Follow safeguarding policies
- Report allegations or suspicions immediately to a relevant authority
- Take pride in being part of the YCRA community

2 Responsible Adults

The following applies to any adult in a position of responsibility or authority.

- Recognise that you are in a position of responsibility and act accordingly (you're part of the development of the next generation of ringers)
- Be approachable
- Listen to and acknowledge all members especially regardless of age or ringing ability
